RESOLUTION

Resolution adopted and approved by the delegates in Plenary Session during the 13th Continental Asia Conference of the Christian Family Movements October 24-27, 2025 at Singapore with the theme “UNLEASHING THE JOY OF THE GOSPEL: EMBRACING THE CALL TO MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP”.

In the current Asian Context, the Christian Family Movement aims to unleash a renewed fervor for missionary discipleship in the spirit of “**communion, participation and mission**”, rooted in the Joy of the Gospel and expressed through the **dialogue of life, faith, and action** — within families, among peoples, and with the broader creation.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that this 13th Continental Asia Conference adopt the following Resolutions:

1. To actively engage in missionary discipleship with a focus on youth through encounter programs such as, but not limited to, Sons & Daughters, the Young Adults Programs, and Self Encounter Programs – while developing new youth-specific initiatives. These efforts aim to cultivate the habits of discipleship and foster leadership and faith in the younger generations, while remaining rooted in the “family as a domestic church” and embodying Gospel values.
2. To strengthen existing Christian Family Movements by sharing best practices, fostering cross-border mentorship, and reinforcing the “Observe–Judge–Act” (OJA) methodology - thereby ensuring that communities journey together, translate their reflections into prayer and missionary action, expand their reach to the peripheries – the marginalized and the poorest & address the current ecological challenges as well as the underlying structures of sin. Through dialogue within families, parishes, and society, CFM will lay the foundations for evangelization for the current and future generations.
3. To foster the growth of new Christian Family Movement communities in countries where the Movement is absent or dormant — as a commitment to family evangelization — by sharing family-centric programs, that enable families to create the next generation of missionary disciples, while equipping emerging leaders through structured training and mentorship led by an appointed mission team.
4. To evangelize effectively in a digital world, leveraging digital platforms
 - As powerful tools for effectively carrying out the mission brought out in the previous three resolutions, thereby achieving the proposed objectives.
 - To collaborate with the ACCFM member countries as well as Catholic Movements and Institutions that share similar objectives as CFM to create synergy and improve digital capability, to drive better reach and impact.
5. In the spirit of stewardship, we will contribute to the promotion and development of existing and future CFM chapters across Asia, while also investing in the spiritual growth and formation of CFM leaders and members.

These resolutions will serve as a guide towards achieving CFM’s goals over the next three years, with progress reviewed via the ACCFM board meetings on a regular basis.


